Eve Lambert is the pseudonym of a successful German writer. Just like her eponymous heroine, Jackie Dupont, she was born to travel: Born in Tessin in 1979, she grew up in Hamburg, Italy and Great Britain and now lives again in Hamburg. When she happens to be not writing she works as a tourist guide, showing the hanseatic city to visitors from all over the world.

London, 1920. During a dazzling party held in Buckingham Palace's gilded rooms, a precious crown is stolen. The royal family seeks help from Jackie Dupont, a private detective with a penchant for diamond thefts, deep-red lipstick, elegant evening gowns – and for somewhat idiosyncratic methods.

Dupont promptly invites the suspects to a weekend at a small hunting lodge in the country. But on the very first evening, one of her guests drops dead, apparently poisoned. And soon Jackie herself is in grave danger ...
