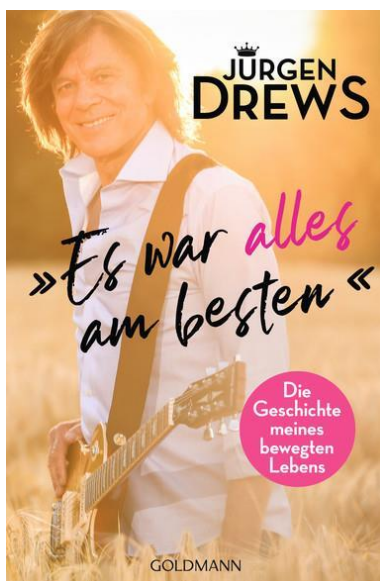

Jürgen Drews is one of the most successful and popular German-language pop stars. Born in Berlin in April 1945, he developed an interest in music early on, performing with local bands and being named best banjo player in Schleswig Holstein at the age of fifteen. In 1969 he met the musician Les Humphries, and joined the Les Humphries Singers before launching his peerless solo career in the early 1970s.

Jürgen Drews is one of the most successful German-language pop singers and a celebrated actor. Almost everyone in Germany knows him from his countless hits and his fans adore him.

The year 2020 marks his 75th birthday, and to celebrate the occasion he has written a book which, for the first time, tells his eventful life story. Here, he reveals all as he recounts his tough beginnings as well as his high points, laughs at mishaps, and even delves into the dark side of the business. This major autobiography grants fans of the 'King of Mallorca' intimate access to his life – an honest, open, personal and richly illustrated book.
