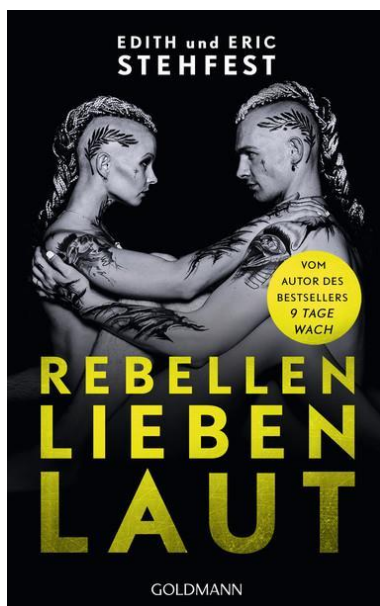


Finally – the bestselling author Eric Stehfest continues his trip

The artist **Eric Stehfest**, born in 1989, lives in Berlin with his family. His bestselling 2016 book *9 Tage wach* – the story of his early years and his addiction to crystal meth – was adapted for television in 2020. The non-profit literacy organisation Stiftung Lesen has recommended that *9 Tage wach* should be read by every schoolchild.

Edith Stehfest, born in 1995, had a turbulent and drug-filled childhood, and fought hard to forge a career as a singer and actor. Her first solo album, *Exit*, appeared in 2019. She was nominated for the 'best narrator' award at the 2019 German Audiobook Prize.

Despite their youth, bestselling author Eric Stehfest and his wife Edith have already experienced more than their fair share: a dysfunctional childhood, early drug addiction, withdrawal, and all sorts of escapades. Then they fall in love, marry and have a son. But traditional marriage constructs and other social norms are not for these two free spirits. They realise that they don't really know themselves, and set out on a necessary, though painful, journey to discover their true nature, campaigning for a different way of living – one that will give each of us a chance to find their own way through life, unshackled by social norms.

In their powerfully written and uninhibited book, Eric and Edith reveal how they managed to recreate themselves, and honestly and unsparingly chart their highs and lows. The highly anticipated sequel to the brilliant bestseller *9 Tage wach* (*Awake for 9 Days*).
