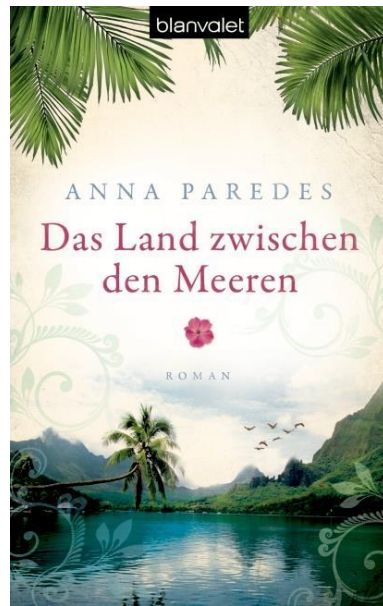


In the land of the coffee blossom, a young woman looking for happiness...
