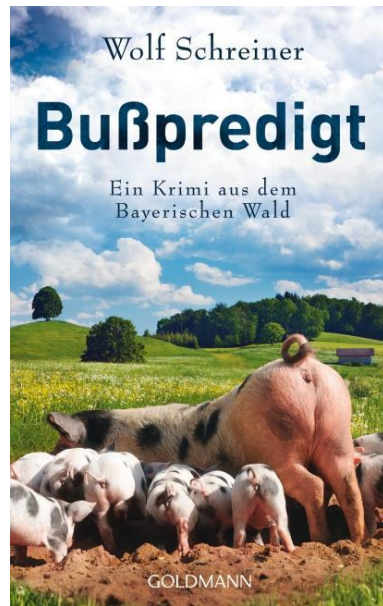


Almighty! A kind-hearted deed in a small village parish has a fatal ending...
