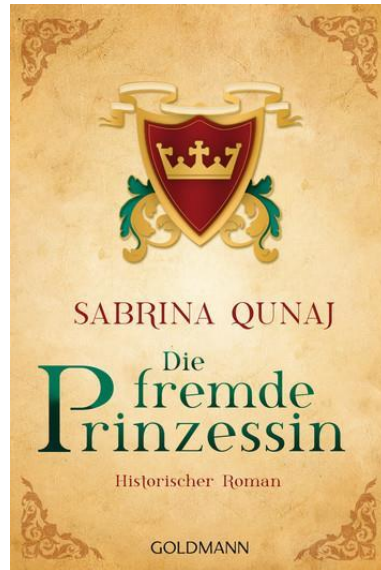


A rugged country, a foreign princess and a love that sets off a war
