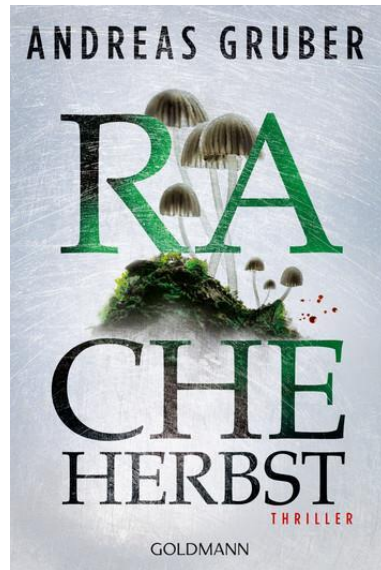


His victims are young women, he murders under the sign of the Scorpion – and leaves a trail of blood

Under a bridge in Leipzig the mutilated body of a young woman is washed up. Walter Pulaski, a cynical police investigator, quickly realises that the murder of prostitute Natalie does not enjoy the highest priority among his colleagues.

He investigates off his own bat – at his side Natalie's mother, Mikaela, who is determined to revenge her daughter's death, at all costs. The two of them come across the bloody trail of a serial murder going to Prague and then Passau and on to Vienna.
