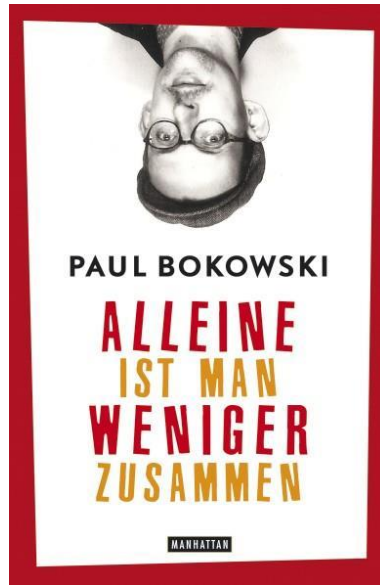


## Humour as dry as dust and brilliant powers of observation

**Paul Bokowski** was born in 1982 and is an author, reader and story teller. 2012 saw the publication of his surprising bestseller *The Main Thing is It's Got Nothing to Do with People*. The 'Woody Allen of Wedding' comes from a German-Polish family and in his second life is a passionate baking blogger.

Self-confessed neurotic Paul Bokowski uses tact and bang-on analysis to turn the most harmless of situations into wonderfully humorous stories. Like the adventure of a wandering washing machine, for example, or the helplessness of a city dweller at finding a recently hatched chicken in his own kitchen. Or take the silent fight for leg room in crowded trains; or the story of Czech workmen who stay overnight for cost-saving reasons. Paul Bokowski finds absurdities in human relationships and coaxes the greatest possible degree of humour out of insignificant incidences. Apart from the sneaking fear that it really did happen, what remains is the tongue-in-cheek realisation that alone you are less together...
