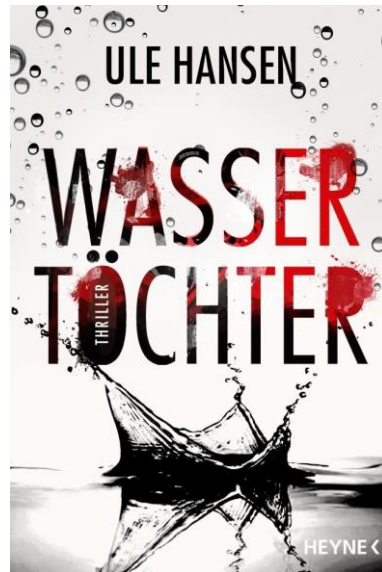


The third and final volume of the gripping Emma Carow series
