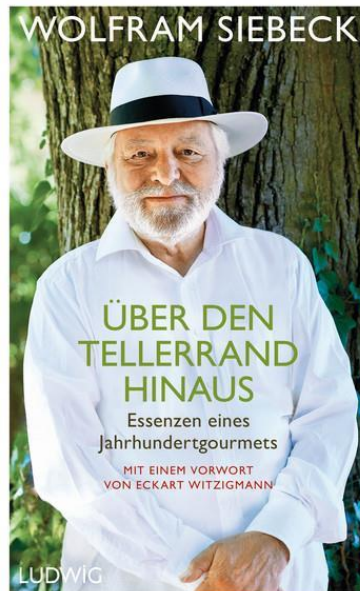


Beware of the lobster!

Wolfram Siebeck, born in 1928, was Germany's best known chef and gastronomy critic, the author of a myriad satirical tales and a host of books about cooking. He also contributed regularly to the *ZEITUNG* on the art of cooking, eating and enjoying food. Wolfram Siebeck died in 2016 at the age of 88.

He was the food taster of the nation, a tireless champion of good taste: whenever Wolfram Siebeck honed his writing knife with stylistic confidence and sounded the attack on fast food, instant meals and factory farming it was enough to make food get stuck in your throat. His sharp tone, his gentle sarcasm, not to forget his wonderful irony – this is what chefs, cooks and gourmets alike loved and revered Siebeck for.

These texts from documents from his estate demonstrate his full mastery – the manuscript of a book he himself composed but which was never published during his lifetime. In the 83 brilliant miniatures about cooking, eating and enjoying food, Siebeck's views and philosophy shine out one more time.
