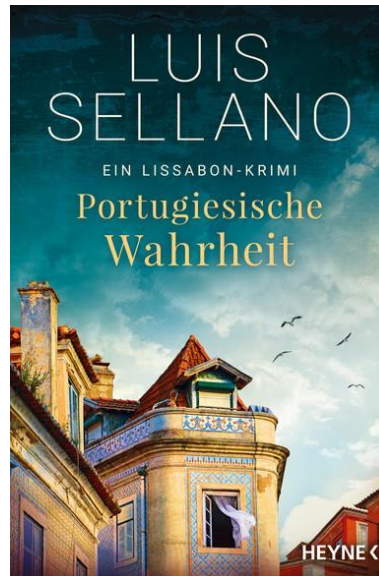


## Pastéis, galão and a corpse in the swimming pool
