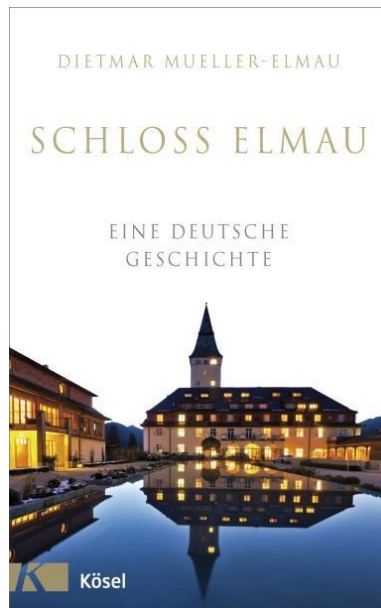

**Dietmar Müller-Elmau** was born in 1954 and studied business administration, philosophy and theology in Munich and computer sciences in New York. In 2007 he recreated the Schloss Elmau built by his grandfather, the philosopher Johannes Müller, as Schloss Elmau – Luxury Spa & Cultural Hideaway.

Schloss Elmau was built in the period 1914-1916 by the philosopher Johannes Müller (1864-1949) as a cultural community centre. Grandson Dietmar Müller-Elmau is also committed to the spiritual inspiration of the building and its grounds and now provides a top-quality cultural and artistic programme to give today's visitors the opportunity of rest and relaxation through mental stimulation.

His interest in his grandfather's ideals was the key for Dietmar Müller-Elmau to understanding the most important stations of the history of Schloss Elmau and to seeing the architectural concept and ideas behind the palace as a political project. This is the essence of this book.
