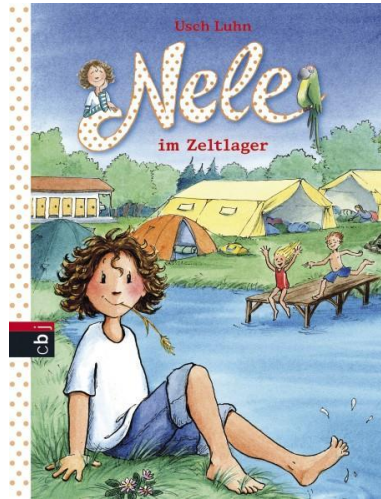


# Nele – New adventures in Cuckoo Stone Castle
