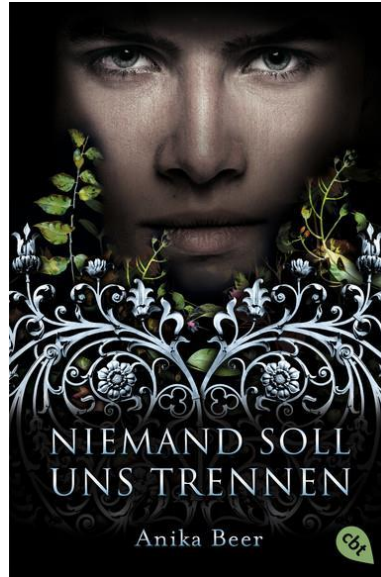


Two brothers, a girl and a sinister secret
