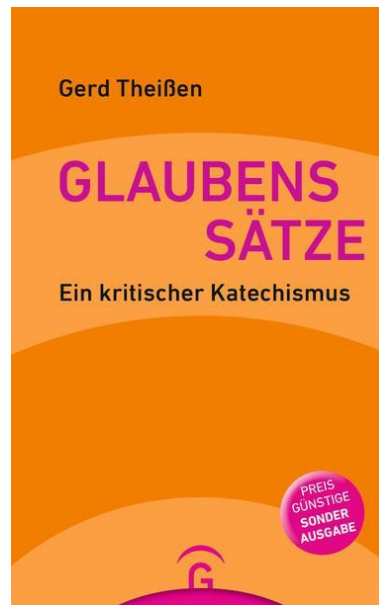

Gerd Theißen, born in 1943, is emeritus professor of New Testament theology at the University of Heidelberg.
