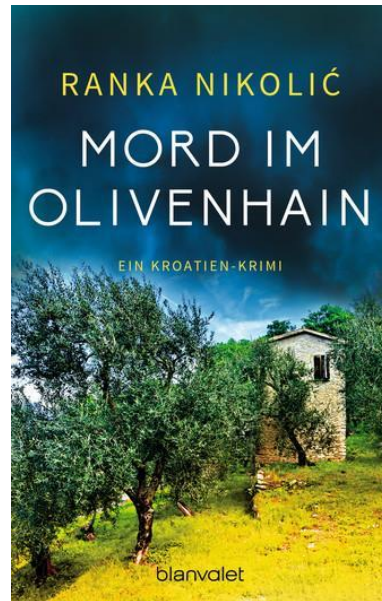


## False promises and greed for money – Sandra Horvat's second case
