Nico Sternbaum is a bestselling writer and illustrator. Even as a child he loved drawing and making up his own stories. When he was older he studied at an art academy, and he now freelances as an illustrator and author. When he is not in his studio he is travelling, reading books or visiting museums and exhibitions. His books have been widely praised in the media, translated into other languages (among them Chinese) and several titles have been promoted and recommended by the German Reading Foundation.

Cutting out, sticking, colouring – these are the basic skills children age three and up can practice with this book. Nico Sternbaum has designed motifs that children can first cut out, then stick on the appropriate illustration before colouring them. There are short texts to go with the pictures: Fish Anton and Paul have a swimming race, some children fly their kites or two ladybirds crawl over the meadow. In the end, the young artists have not only created 14 attractive pictures but also have gained a scissors-user licence.
